Donald Paul has served 32 years with the Chevron Corporation. Don joined the company in 1975 as a research geophysicist in La Habra, California. During his 32-year career, Don has held a variety of management positions of increasing responsibility in both the upstream business and technology, including president of Chevron Petroleum Technology Co., and president of Chevron Canada Resources Ltd., the Canadian oil and gas exploration and production subsidiary of Chevron.

In his last position he served as the vice president and chief technology officer. Don was the corporate officer responsible for Chevron's three technology companies: Energy Technology, Information Technology and Technology Ventures. In this role, he managed the research, development and integrated application of technology throughout the company's worldwide business activities. Don was extensively involved in external research and technology collaborations with universities, government agencies and professional technical societies. Don also served as an advisory board member of the FreedomCAR and Fuel Program of the U. S. Department of Energy and was team leader on the National Petroleum Council's energy report to the Secretary of Energy completed in 2007.

A native of Los Angeles, California, Don is a graduate of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, with a bachelor's degree in applied mathematics, a master's degree in geology and geophysics and a Ph.D. in geophysics.
